

## **Operation Stand Down Tennessee 2018 Impact Report**

From January 1 to December 31, 2018 the following outcomes were achieved:

- 2,794 men and women Veterans received services in our Veteran Service Centers (21% increase from 2017) 77% were non-homeless and 23% homeless)
- 83 cents of every dollar donated to OSDTN was used to serve Veterans and their families,
- 266 Veterans found or upgraded their employment through our Career Services Department (4% increase from 2017),
- 125 men and women Veterans participated in our Transitional Housing Program with 77% leaving successfully (6.5% increase in leaving successfully from 2017),
- 1,814 Veterans and their families were assisted in filing disability claims (60% increase from 2017),
- 218 Veterans and their families received financial assistance to either move from being homeless into permanent housing or to remain in their homes (46% increase from 2017),
- 643 Veterans received 4,114 free clothing items valued at thrift store prices of \$23,380, and
- 318 volunteers contributed 3,388 hours at our Veteran Service Centers - this is a per hour value of \$24.69 totaling \$83,649.72.
